Sarah Temporal

Sarah is a prize-winning performance poet, writer, cultural producer, and former English teacher, who loves empowering people of all ages through the spoken and written word. You can find her work in *Best of Australian Poems* and many literary journals. Sarah has delivered poetry learning experiences with Red Room Poetry, Storyboard, and Kyogle Writers Festival, and now runs a youth writing masterclass in Murwillumbah. She is the founder of Poets Out Loud and director of the Youth Slam in partnership with Byron Writers Festival.

Jedda Winkworth

Jedda is a writer and poet who is passionate about the power of spoken word to move, heal and inspire change. She was selected to represent Griffith University in slam poetry demonstrations at the 2018 Georgetown Festival, Malaysia. Published in *Talent Implied Anthology*, *Getamugstit* magazine and *Healing Times* magazine, Jedda is also the winner of the People's Choice Award at the 2022 Nimbin Performance Poetry Cup.



Katinka Smit

Katinka Smit began performing as a poet alongside an acting career (mostly theatre) in Newcastle in the 90s. She has worked as a life skills coach with disadvantaged youth, as a speech and drama tutor in youth theatre, and volunteer for the Byron Writers Festival's Storyboard and youth master class sessions. She was a 2018 finalist in the Nimbin Performance Poetry Cup.
